BOARDING HOMES NEEDED FOR GUIDE DOGS IN TRAINING

BC & Alberta Guide Dogs needs volunteers to provide boarding homes for adult dogs that are training to be Guide Dogs for blind/visually-impaired persons, or Autism Support Dogs for children aged 3-10 with moderate to severe autism.

WE ARE LOOKING FOR VOLUNTEERS TO:

- board an adult dog (already house-trained) for approximately 5 months
- provide a loving home for the dog on evenings and weekends

BOARDERS SHOULD:

- live in the Ladner or Tsawwassen area
- be at home during the day or able to take the dog along when leaving home
- provide a dog-friendly home preferably with a secure outdoor space
- follow BC & Alberta Guide Dogs guidelines for training and caring for the dog



Monday through Friday, our staff will pick up the dog for training around 9:00 am and drop the dog off around 4:00 pm. The charity provides food, vet care, and other basic necessities for the dog.
